Minus 31 degrees centigrade. Snow, ice, mountains and the fiord. And the Arctic Circle and Santa Claus!

Simone, highly-gifted singer, has just returned from Greenland with a suitcase full of wonderful memories and hundreds of pictures from a beautiful scenery beyond the usual...



It was extreme weather conditions which hit Simone, as there at the intermediate landing in Soenderstroem Fiord was minus 31 degrees centigrade.

"I could hardly breathe and cheeks shrank in the cold. The weather was very clear and the sun was shining throughout the weekend. Can you wish for more?" asks Simone, who was invited to Greenland to sing at the Hotel Hans Egede in Nuuk.

Simone was in company with her mother and her pianist. Three women with a passion for music and singing, but indeed also with a passion for snow and wild nature. And they were not disappointed.

"I took over 500 pictures - but mostly of the wild nature. Both the panoramic images and pictures



taken up close, so you can see the sunlight playing in the blue colour of the ice" says Simone enthusiastic and has only one desire back to put in Santa's mailbox: "I've lost my heart to Greenland and it is certainly not the last time I'm there. But next time it will be either further north or at the east coast. And then strapped to the sled dogs!" It is forbidden to have sled dogs south of the Arctic Circle in West Greenland - in Nuuk. So dogsled journey, she has still to come.
